Although grade 3 students will still undertake the writing in its traditional form, all other assessments (Year 5 Writing, Language Convention, Reading and Numeracy) will now be undertaken via a NAP lockdown app. The recent trial period has enabled students and teachers to become familiar with the new assessment platform in readiness for NAPLAN in May.
