## **Victorian Curriculum**

In the Victorian Curriculum F–10, the Technologies includes Design and Technology and Digital Technologies.

The Technologies provide a framework for students to learn how to use technologies to create innovative solutions that meet current and future needs. Students are encouraged to make decisions about the development and use of technologies, considering the impacts of technological change and how technologies may contribute to a sustainable future. The curriculum provides practical opportunities for students to be users, designers and producers of new technologies.

In Design and Technologies, students use design thinking and technologies to generate and produce designed solutions. In Digital Technologies, students use computational thinking and information systems to analyse, design and develop digital solutions.

## **Family Share**

Williamstown Primary school highly recommends the use of family share when setting up accounts for students.

This will enable parents to set up Apple IDs for their children while giving them full control of key set up and access features. Family share also enables families to share apps, saving in the purchasing of apps. This is extremely beneficial when purchasing the school app list which can then be share amongst siblings.

Family share's security settings gives parents full control of the management of their child's device.

Note: At times browser security settings applied to the account by parent can have impact on safari's search ability when at school. The school's wifi network has DET filtering software. If you have concerns regarding the use of safari at home we recommend the use of a 3<sup>rd</sup> party browser app such as Kidzsearch. This app can be downloaded for free on your child's iPad.

Students will be assisted in managing their iPads and apps while being encouraged to use the devices in a safe learning environment. Students will be educated and supported regarding eSmart and Cyber safety procedures. This will be incorporated within the student user agreement.

Staff at Williamstown PS undertake ongoing Professional Development in digital pedagogy and device use within core curriculum areas in delivering a relevant and essential curriculum.

Students will have their iPads connected to the school WiFi network while receiving trouble-shooting support regarding their daily use.

Provide an environment where students will be encouraged to think critically, communicate and collaborate with one another through the use of digital technologies eLearning platforms.

Each classroom will have secure facilities for iPads to be stored when not in use. This includes 10 minutes before the commencement of school, during recess and lunch times. Students will not be permitted to take iPads out during these breaks.

Students will be enrolled in the DET licensed Google for Education, in which they will have DET secure Google accounts.

Students who do not have a personal iPad will have access to a shared school iPad mini.

**Note: the school is currently investigating the ability to have temporary apps distributed to student iPads through its MDM (Mobile Device Management) system.**
